Violinist Cho-Liang Lin is lauded over the world for the eloquence of his playing and for the superb musicianship that marks his performances. An avid chamber musician, Mr. Lin appears at the Beijing Music Festival, and makes regular appearances performing at the Chamber Music Society of Lincoln Center, the Aspen Music Festival, and Santa Fe Chamber Music Festival. Mr Lin has also been the Music Director of La Jolla Music Society's SummerFest since 2001. Lin's extensive discography includes recordings for Sony Classical, Decca, Ondine, Naxos and BIS. His albums have won such awards as

Gramophone's Record of the Year, as well as two Grammy Award nominations. In 2000, Musical America named Mr. Lin its Instrumentalist of the Year. He was invited to join the faculty of the Juilliard School in 1991. More recently he was appointed professor of violin at Rice University's Shepherd School of Music. He plays the 1715 "Titian" Stradivarius.

小提琴家林昭亮 備受世界讚譽,演奏極富感染力,展現出卓越的音樂才華。無論與世界知名樂團合作室樂演出,及音樂教學都表現卓絕。作爲熱衷的室樂音樂家,林昭亮除了參加北京音樂節之外,也經常在紐約林肯中心室內樂協會音樂季、阿斯本音樂節、聖達菲室內音樂節等演出。自二零零一年起,林昭亮擔任拉荷亞音樂協會"仲夏音樂節"的音樂總監。林昭亮的音樂錄音全輯內容豐富,包括爲索尼古典音樂、Decca、Ondine、Naxos 和 BIS等灌制的專輯。他的專輯榮獲多個獎項,包括被《留聲機》雜誌評爲「年度最佳唱片」和兩次獲格萊美獎提名。二零零零年,被《音樂美國》(Musical America)雜誌評選爲「年度器樂演奏家」。一九九一年,他獲邀執教茱莉亞音樂學院;最近,他被聘爲萊斯大學 Shepherd 音樂學院的小提琴教授。他演奏用的琴是斯特拉迪瓦裡在一七一五年製成的"提香"。
